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Context of lesson

The class are early on in the second unit of the course, preparing for examination Paper 2, (essay paper, genre Drama)

Play being studied: Edward Bond's *Lear*.
Students have read acts one and two.

Learning Objectives

- To introduce Paper 2 style questions
- To demonstrate layers of meaning in essay questions
- To give students a way of visualising the question

Structure of the lesson

Activity:	Timing:
Teacher led introduction, Q and A to establish key words of the question and the idea of layers within a question.	5 minutes
Activity 1: Role on the Wall – activity and purpose explained, completed activity displayed.	15 minutes
Whole group exploration of key term “struggle” and further discussion of question	10 minutes
Activity 2: Role on the Stage – using terms from activity 1 individual work	15 minutes
Plenary: discuss individual work and refocus on question.	5 minutes

Outcomes:
Further work on the essay question will be undertaken in the next two lessons, and then the essay will be set as an assignment.

Progression:
Students will build up confidence with this style of question prior to the summer exam, which is closed text and two hours.
